## Swap-Up Morning:

As our Year 6 pupils are due to attend Cardinal Hume for the day on Monday  $3^{rd}$  (and Tuesday  $4^{th}$ ), we are using **Monday 3^{rd} July** as the ideal time to hold a swap-up morning.

Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July will act as a transition morning for all pupils in our current Reception to Year 5 classes. They will 'move' to the next class and meet their teachers.

Our incoming Reception cohort are being notified about a welcome stay and play session, with a grown-up on this day. We will also use this as an opportunity for our Year 2 pupils to sample life at the junior school.

On this day, we ask that our Year 2 pupils are dropped off at the junior school between 8:30am and 8:55am. Pupils will experience how our start of day procedures work, where things are, how lunchtimes work and will get to play on the fabulous climbing frames! Pupil will have lunch at the junior school, and we will walk pupils back down to the infant school, after dinnertime has ended. Please book lunch as normal, and we will ensure that this provided on the day, at the junior school. We will be holding an incoming Year 3 Parents' transition session at the juniors on the evening of Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July at 3:45pm (this is for current Year 2 parents).

## **School Day:**

It has come to our attention that a number of pupils are being taken from school early, on an afternoon, as opposed to staying until 3:15pm or 3:30pm. Please note that we are duty bound to ensure that pupils remain in education for 32.5 hours per week and should a pattern begin to emerge, then we will have no option but to refer families to the Education Welfare Officer. Thank you for your cooperation.

## Year 6 Celebrations:

As we have now had our Masses for this term, confirmed – we are now in a position to be able to share our end of term arrangements for Year 6 pupils.

On **Wednesday 19**th **July – at 9:30am,** we will host our Year 6 Leavers' Assembly in school, where **Year 6 parents/carers** are invited to attend.

The Year 6 pupils' final event is due to take place on **Friday 21**st **July – at 10am**, where they will lead us in their final Mass as a cohort.



# **SEND Support Meetings:**

For those pupils who are on the official SEND register, we will hold face to face meetings with our parents, where we will review their SEND Pupil Support Plan (PSP). At the start of this year, all parents/carers of those pupils who have a SEND need and required placement on our SEND register, were informed by letter. We review PSPs twice a year, and would like to take this opportunity for you to meet Mrs Maddock/Mrs Peacock in a face to face meeting, where your child's targets will be reviewed, before they are handed onto their teacher, next year.

Dates for these meetings are scheduled for Thursday 29th and Friday 30th June.
