FUN-draising!

Last week, our recently formed FUN-draising group had an excellent first meeting. They are eager to help raise funds to improve our Early Years area, as well as supplementing our playing facilities across both schools and helping us to offset some costs for educational visits. The group are very enthusiastic about the prospect of working alongside our local businesses and have managed to secure several donated prizes in a very short space of time!

The main FUN-draising event that the group wishes to coordinate is a summer fayre at St. Joseph's Catholic Infant School, on Friday 5th July, commencing at 2:15pm. All funds raised will be match-funded by Barclays Bank PLC; we therefore want to make the most out of this fantastic opportunity.

Governors have given permission for our pupils to be collected from their respective schools, at 2:15pm on Friday 5th July. The PTA, who are organising the event, are therefore grateful for any donations – big or small – that our parents and carers can contribute to raffle prizes. Donations can be made at either school.
